



Marine Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation Project



Southbound I-270 Marine Avenue bridge

MoDOT and contractor Fred Weber will begin the bridge repairs on the southbound section of the I-270 bridge over Marine Avenue, in the city of Maryland Heights on Wednesday, June 1.

During the bridge work, all four lanes of southbound I-270 will remain open. The exit only lane from Dorsett Road to westbound Page Avenue/Route 364 will be closed so motorists will need to be in the right lane of southbound I-270 to access Page Avenue/Route 364/Bennington Place.

The work will be done in stages, meaning traffic shifts on I-270 will occur. During the traffic shifts, MoDOT will keep open four through lanes on southbound I-270.

MoDOT asks motorists to please pay attention, as speed limits will be reduced to 45 mph, lanes will be narrower with no shoulders and barrier wall will be in place. Signs, lane markings and temporary rumble strips will be laid on the interstate to warn motorists of the approaching work zone and to guide motorists through the work zone.

Weather permitting, work will proceed continuously, in order to complete this work as quickly as possible. Residents, businesses, and local hotels will experience some inconvenience of construction noise and rumble strip noise. We apologize about this inconvenience.



Some minor traffic delays may be experienced during peak periods, although these periods are less significant during the summer months when school is out.

Once work is completed on the southbound section, crews will move to the northbound section of the I-270 bridge over Marine Avenue.

Work on each section of bridge is expected to take about two months, weather permitting.

The existing I-270 bridges over Marine Avenue were built in 1965. This project includes bridge rehabilitation and a new driving surface on the existing bridges.
